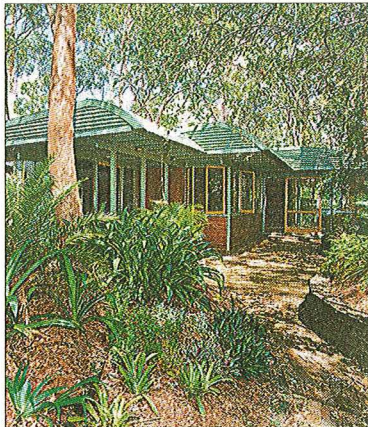


## **AUTHOR'S LEAFY HOME** **INDOOROOPILLY, QUEENSLAND**

Designed by pole-house architect Donald Spencer, the Mt Coot-tha home of author **Nicole Carew-Reid** and her husband, Jeremy, makes the most of its inner-city bush setting. On a 1647 square-metre block on Blackstone Street at the base of Mt Coot-tha near Indooroopilly in Brisbane's west, it has been home to the couple and their two children for 11 years. Reflecting its location, the home has ash timber floors, wood-panelled walls and walkways between living areas. The extensions were supervised by Spencer in keeping with the original plans. It has four bedrooms across two levels and the lounge and dining areas open onto full-length decks. The rear of the house opens to another deck,



overlooking the swimming pool. More than \$1 million is expected at the March 28 auction. Johnston Dixon Quality Property agent Carol Roberts has the listing.
